

he Saint Camillus Center Awards are presented to individuals and groups for their outstanding service and dedication to the communities served by Saint Camillus Center for Spiritual Care and its ministries. In their professional work and volunteer work, they share in the mission and vision of Saint Camillus Center to "accompany people with hope."

FATHER ROBERT JONES AWARD

Originally called the Deacon James Dillon Award, this award is given to a person or group who shares the Saint Camillus Center's commitment to spiritual care of patients in our hospitals but also in various urban settings. Deacon Jim died in 2007 after having served our patients for many years. Fr. Bob Jones, CM died in 2020 after serving as chaplain for over 21 years. He mentored many of our chaplain trainees and he was much loved by medical staff and patients as well as by his fellow chaplains.

JOHN AUGUST SWANSON AWARD

This award was originally called the Msgr. William Barry Award after a well-loved priest who passed away in 2007. He was a messenger for outreach, interfaith and inclusive ministry since Vatican II.

John August Swanson was a world renowned artist and a friend and supporter of Saint Camillus Center for many decades. His art reflected the strong heritage of storytelling he inherited from his Mexican mother and Swedish father. Swanson's narrative was direct and easily understood. He addressed human values, cultural roots, and the quest for self-discovery through visual images. His parables optimistically embrace life and spiritual transformation.

A number of John's serigraphs grace the walls of Saint Camillus Chapel. The John August Swanson award is given to a person or group that serves with joy, moving us from charity for one person at a time, to social justice solidarity and action.

MARY LOUIS BREEN PONNET AWARD

This award honors Fr. Chris Ponnet's mother who was a Registered Nurse all of her professional life providing direct service care to patients at Queen of Angels, LAC+USC and Alhambra Community hospitals. A widowed mother of eight children, Mary Ponnet, and her daughter Jeanne Yugar, RN, remain an inspiration to Fr. Chris Ponnet. We honor all who work at the bedside and provide direct care for the persons we serve.

SAINT CAMILLUS DE LELLIS AWARD

"The poor and the sick are the heart of God. In serving them we serve Jesus the Lord."

Camillus was born at Bacchianico, Naples, 1550; died at Rome, 14 July, 1614. The son of an officer who had served both in the Neapolitan and French armies, his mother died when he was a child, and he grew up absolutely neglected. While in the service he became a gambler and was at times reduced to a condition of destitution. In Rome, he obtained employment in the Hospital for Incurables after going there chiefly for the hope of a cure of abscesses in both his feet from which he had been long suffering. He entered the hospital in which he had previously been and he was eventually appointed director of the hospital. On the advice of his friends, among whom was his spiritual guide,

St. Philip Neri, he determined to become a priest.

He established his order, the Fathers of a Good Death (1584), and bound the members by vow to devote themselves to the plague-stricken; their work was not restricted to the hospitals, but included the care of the sick in their homes. In 1591 Gregory XIV erected the congregation into a religious order, with all the privileges of the mendicants. Near death, he would permit no one to wait on him,

and when scarcely able to stand would crawl out of his bed to visit the sick.

He was beatified in 1742, and in 1746 was canonized by Benedict XIV. In 1930, Pope Pius XI named St. Camillus de Lellis, together with St. John of God, "principal Co-Patrons of nurses and of nurses' associations."

GOOD SAMARITAN AWARD

This award is inspired by the sacred story from the Gospel of Luke 10:25-37 where Jesus tells us "who is our neighbor." The award honors a person or group whose partnership in Saint Camillus Center's Vision and Mission recognizes the larger and diverse communities that Saint Camillus Center strives to serve.
